- Why is the Pesticide Label important?

Pesticide label provides important information on:



Product details



Directions on how to use,
store and dispose



Potential hazards

• Important information in the Pesticide Label



CONCENTRATION OF THE ACTIVE INGREDIENT (e.g. 75%) and FORMULATION (e.g. wettable powder or WP)

COLOR CODING (Green, Blue, Yellow and Red) and PICTOGRAMS See **Safe Use of Pesticide** for more information.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Crop(s), pests, dosage, mixing and dilution of the product, time of application, incompatibilities, application method etc.

Note: Always follow the direction!

RE-ENTRY PERIOD

- Time you are allowed to enter after spraying
- e.g. 12 hours after spraying

PRE-HARVEST INTERVAL

- Time to wait between pesticide application and when a crop can be harvested
- e.g. 14 days for all crops

FIRST AID & MEDICAL ADVICE

- What should you do when it accidentally gets into your mouth, skin or eyes?

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- How and where to store?
- How to handle leftovers and empty container?
